### School Uniform

Your child should always come to school wearing a full uniform unless it is their PE day or a special non uniform day. This should include bags and coats and when needed hats and water bottles.

Please note all children from Year 1 to 6 should be wearing a tie with a shirt/blouse with a collar, not a polo shirt.

### Attendance

As we start the new academic year, the usual rules of attendance apply. We expect all children to arrive on time. Please ensure you allow enough time for any traffic. If your child is unwell, you must notify the school office by 8:30am via email [office@olsgschool.org](mailto:office@olsgschool.org) or telephone. Do avoid making appointments during the school day where possible. If persistent absence or lateness occurs, a letter will be issued and a referral to the Education Welfare Office will be made. We also discourage parents from taking their child/ren out of school during term time for holidays as these will be recorded as unauthorised absences. We fully understand exceptional circumstances arise and these will have to be authorised by our Head Teacher once a 'leave of absence form' has been completed, these can be obtained from either school office.

We are looking forward to welcoming you to our International Cultural Heritage Day next Friday. This annual event always proves to be very popular. All parents/carers are very welcome. There will be performances from children from Years 1 to Year 6 in the afternoon at Upper Site. The
