Dear Parents/Carers,

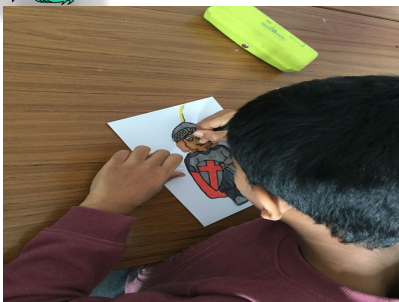
Welcome back to the second week of the Summer Term, the last term of this school year. We hope you all had a restful and Holy Easter break.
